The author makes us feel so much sympathy right in the very first chapter where Annie is humiliated by this ass Shane when he asks her to go with him

to Homecoming. And she has this short, absolutely unwelcome but still intense, moment where she thinks that he might be honest instead of making fun of her. Geez, my heart broke for her because I could understand her so much. We all know those stupid hopeful thoughts when reason clearly states something else.
