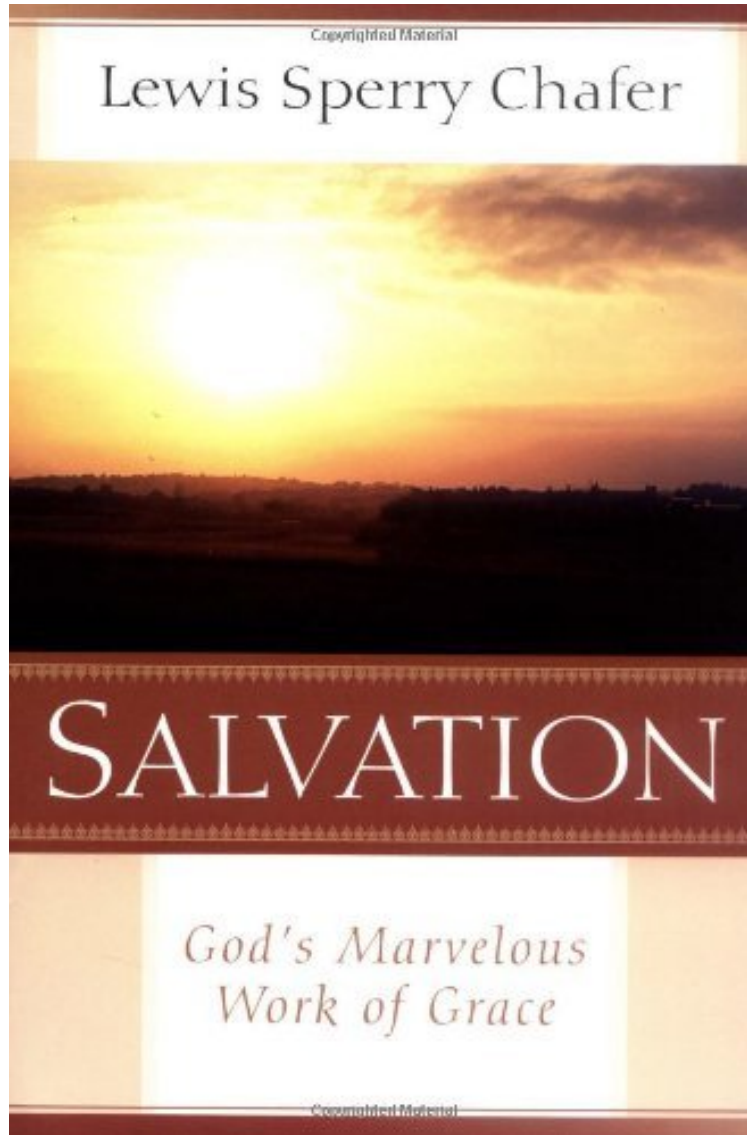

Griffith Thomas Lewis Sperry Chafer (1871-1952), American Presbyterian clergyman and educator, was born in Rock Creek, Ohio; studied at New Lyme Academy and Oberlin Conservatory and College; and studied under C. I. Scofield. Ordained in 1900, Chafer had diverse talents. He was a traveling evangelist and a Bible lecturer, he taught Bible at Philadelphia School of the Bible, and for many years was the editor of the theological journal *Bibliotheca Sacra*. In 1924 he founded the Evangelical Theological College (now Dallas Theological Seminary) and was its president and a professor of systematic theology until his death. His many other works include *Satan: His Motives and Methods*, *True Evangelism*, *The Kingdom in History and Prophecy*, *He That Is Spiritual*, *Grace*, *Major Bible Themes*, *The Ephesian Letter*, and the eight-volume *Systematic Theology*.
